Thank you Catechists, we did it! Together we can make anything possible!

With great satisfaction I can say that this May we fulfilled another year in the catechetical program. It was a year of much teaching where our valuable catechists taught different topics to enhance the knowledge of our students, both in first year and the second year of catechism. During the first year, the students are taught to pray and to understand the stories that Jesus told, His parables, His miracles, His suffering on the cross and His glorious resurrection. During the second year, we review what the students learned the previous year and the students are taught how to read the Sacred Scripture, the sacraments, stories of the saints. At this level, they are also taught how to integrate the teachings of Jesus into their lives. In the first months of the second year of the program, the students are taught together with their parents through special classes with the theme of Reconciliation and in the last months they are taught the theme of the Eucharist.

On Sunday, May 5, 40 children together with their parents, godparents and relatives celebrated their First Communion.

The teens preparing to receive the sacrament of Confirmation review what they have learned in previous years about Jesus, the Sacred Scripture, the Sacraments, and more. Since this is an advanced level, they are invited to participate in two retreats so that they can assimilate more. They are also invited to participate in the Church life, to spend time with each other in a healthy way with activities appropriate to their age.

On April 27, 40 teenagers had the good fortune to receive the sacrament of Confirmation in the Saint Joseph's Cathedral in San José. Bishop Oscar Cantú presided over the ceremony, along with 60 other teens from other parishes.

We are blessed to have excellent catechists who, every Sunday during nine months offer up their precious time to teach our students, we greatly thank them for their dedication and effort.

And of course the parents who entrust their children to us for their spiritual education so that these children, who are the future of our Church, can be committed Catholics just as our parishioners in our beloved parish of St. Athanasius are. I ask for your prayers so that in these children receive the grace of God abundantly.

I take this opportunity to invite you to register your children to the Summer Bible School on August 5-9.




