Awesome Parish Pioneers!



Last Saturday, May 18th, at the request of Fr. Oscar, the parish put on a buffet lunch for, what Father calls, our “Parish Pioneers.” These are parishioner who have been coming to St. Athanasius for 30 years or more. Since much of our parish encompasses an area that has always been fairly transitory - with people in apartments and condos moving in and out all the time - I was pleased that we had 55 Pioneers turn out for this event. It was gratifying to be able to formally thank them for helping to build up the parish and helping it survive to the present day.

We were especially blessed to have some parishioners in attendance who have been here since the parish was founded in 1959! These included: Larry Gugliemelli, Bernie Barron, Manuel and Gloria Ramirez, Jim Cesano, Violet Brletich, Reuben Sierras, Don and Theresa Maxwell, Carolyn Molinari, John Avila, Peter Taskovich, and Teresita Densing. Our Pioneers have seen many priests, sisters and lay staff members come and go over the years. They have seen the parish go from diocesan priests, to the Holy Ghost Fathers of Ireland, and, 10 years ago, back to diocesan priests. They welcomed the Sisters of Mercy back in 1965 to run the school and said goodbye to most of them in 1976 when the school closed. Yet these Pioneers stayed and continued to welcome new parishioners and continued to serve the parish in many ways. Thank you so much for your support and dedication to our parish!

One highlight of the luncheon was the Pioneers’ sharing of stories and memories of parish life over the past 60 years. There was also a table of memories with photos and memorabilia for the attendees to look through which sparked many fond memories. This event was the first event in what we hope will be a series of events celebrating the 60th Anniversary of the First Mass in our parish on November 29th, 1959 in what is now our Parish Hall. A lot has changed in Mountain View since 1959 but one thing has remained: A community of disciples of Jesus Christ dedicated to prayer and service and the building up of the Kingdom of God at 160 N. Rengstorff Avenue.

Finally, I want to thank all those who helped make this event happen: Carol Wilson, Peter Taskovich, Mike Cavera, Anna Roquero and Anna Gurado and their children, Fr. Oscar for sharing some humorous stories and an architect’s beautiful rendering of what the church was supposed to look like (it was never built), Fr. Paul for serenading us in song, Betty Dominguez for handling the invitations and the folks at il postale Italian American Bistro in Sunnyvale who supplied the food.

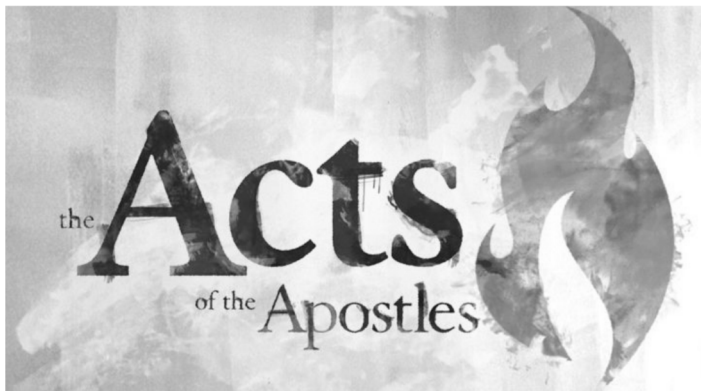
