

**Hello and Then Goodbye, and Hello again...
"Fear is useless. What is needed is Trust," (Mk 5:36).**

Back in March, I received a call from Fr. Peter Loi Huynh, pastor of Our Lady of La-Vang. He asked me whether I would like to work at the Vietnamese parish. I told him that I just came back to St. Athanasius not too long ago, and I'd like to stay here a while longer. Yet, a month later, he called back and said that the decision had already been made that I would come to help him at our Lady of La-Vang. Since I perceived my vocation as being attentive to the needs whenever they arrive, I accepted the decision. Nevertheless, I couldn't help feeling sad leaving the community that I loved. I've just been back at St. Athanasius for almost two years. At the beginning of my reassignment here, I was so happy. I wasted no time getting to work with ministries, including liturgically modifying, beautifying, and designing. With the tireless collaboration of our popular "designer couple", Fran and Sim, we were able to modified old banners as well as making and purchasing new ones for most of the seasons and major feasts. By contributions of generous doners, we were able to purchase sacred vessels for Mass and various liturgical equipment. Then everything was slowing down since my dad died in November 2017. It has been more than a year and I could still feel its impact on me. I've come to realize how important his presence was to me as father, friend, and advisor. The major moral support I had had all my life was take away, I didn't realize it until the sadness seem to drain my energy. On the positive side, the news of reassignment helped waking me up, and I have to reassess my commitment and dedication to pastoral ministries. The Lenten intense prayers helped me to realize that I need to ask God for a renewal of my spirit, to recommit myself as a disciple to the Lord, and to let go of my inherent need for my dad's support. I remember Fr. John Corapi in his talk on Divine Mercy, quoting our Lord: *"Fear is useless. What is needed is Trust,"* (Mk 5:36). The remedy for fear is "trust", he said. With trust in Christ there would be no more fear. Indeed, there's always some uncertainty I feel about my dad. It is the trust in Christ that will help me to move on. The celebration of Easter with the triumphal Resurrection of the Lord ought to shatter all fears of sin and death. This year, I really feel the joy of being able to celebrate with our community at St. Athanasius, beginning with the Lenten Season, ending with Holy Week, culminating with Holy Triduum, and arriving at summit with Easter Vigil. Everything was done beautifully with the collaboration of our Staff, decorators (lead by Mike, Pat, and Peter), Eucharistic ministers, Lectors, ushers, altar servers, Musicians, Choirs, volunteers, donors, etc.. One thing I'd like to mention is that the new beautiful banners of Lent and Easter are actually bought not by me but by Peter. At least, I'm glad that he has caught on with my ideas. All in all, I was ecstatic being able to return to St. Athanasius, but sad having to leave again. Yet, I continue to give thanks to God for the love I've received from our community here, as much as the support and prayers from Fr. Oscar, the Staff, and very special people at St. Athanasius. Moreover, I wish to express the deepest gratitude and appreciation to everyone. Until we meet again, may our Resurrected Lord fill our hearts with His Divine Mercy and love, and may His Holy Spirit, transform us into ever trusting people of God, who wholeheartedly seeking to serve Him without Fear.

BOLETIN HISPANO

Hola y luego adios, y Hola otra vez... "No tengas miedo. Solo ten Fe," (Mc 5:36).

En marzo, recibí una llamada del p. Peter Loi Huynh, pastor de Nuestra Señora de La-Vang. Me preguntó si me gustaría trabajar en la parroquia vietnamita. Le dije que acababa de regresar a San Atanasio, y que me gustaría quedarme aquí un poco más. Sin embargo, un mes más tarde, volvió a llamar y me dijo que ya se había tomado la decisión de irme a ayudarlo en la Iglesia de nuestra Virgen de La-Vang. Percibí que mi vocación es estar atento a las necesidades cada vez que llegaban, acepté la decisión. Sin embargo, no pude evitar sentirme triste al dejar la comunidad que amaba. Acabo de regresar a San Atanasio hace apenas dos años. Al comienzo de mi reasignación aquí, estaba tan feliz. No perdí tiempo en trabajar en los diferentes ministerios, incluida la modificación litúrgica, el embellecimiento y el diseño. Con la colaboración incansable de nuestra popular "pareja de diseñadores", Fran y Sim, pudimos modificar los banners antiguos, así como hacer y comprar nuevos para la mayoría de las temporadas y fiestas principales. Gracias a las contribuciones de donadores generosos, pudimos comprar cálices nuevos para la Misa y varios equipos litúrgicos. Luego todo se desaceleró desde que mi padre murió en noviembre de 2017. Ha pasado más de un año y todavía podía sentir su impacto en mí. Me he dado cuenta de lo importante que era su presencia para mí como padre, amigo y consejero. El mayor apoyo moral que había tenido toda mi vida me fue arrebatado, no me di cuenta hasta que la tristeza parecía agotar mi energía. En el lado positivo, la noticia de la reasignación me ayudó a despertarme, y tengo que reevaluar mi compromiso y dedicación a los ministerios pastorales. Las intensas oraciones de la Cuaresma me ayudaron a darme cuenta de que necesito pedirle a Dios una renovación de mi espíritu, volver a comprometerme como discípulo del Señor y dejar de lado mi necesidad inherente del apoyo de mi padre. Recuerdo al Padre John Corapi en su charla acerca de la Divina Misericordia, citando a nuestro Señor: "No tengas miedo. Solo ten Fe," (Mc 5:36). El remedio para el miedo es la "confianza", dijo. Con confianza en Dios no habrá nada a temer. De hecho, siempre hay cierta incertidumbre sobre mi padre. Es la confianza en Cristo la que me ayudará a seguir adelante. La celebración de la Pascua con la resurrección triunfal del Señor debe destruir todos los temores del pecado y la muerte. Este año, realmente siento mucha alegría de poder celebrar con nuestra comunidad en San Atanasio, comenzando con la temporada de Cuaresma, terminando con la Semana Santa, culminando con el Santo Triduo, y llegando a la cumbre con la Vigilia Pascual. Todo se hizo muy bien con la colaboración de nuestro personal, decoradores (liderados por Mike, Pat y Peter), ministros de Eucaristía, Lectores, servidores, monaguillos, músicos, coros, voluntarios, donadores, etc. Una cosa que me gustaría mencionar es que las nuevas y hermosas banners de Cuaresma y Pascua en realidad no las compre yo sino Peter. Al menos, me alegro de que este siguiendo mis ideas. Con todo, estaba extasiado al poder regresar a San Atanasio, pero triste por tener que irme de nuevo. Sin embargo, sigo agradeciendo a Dios por el amor que he recibido de nuestra comunidad aquí, tanto como el apoyo y las oraciones del Padre. Oscar, el personal y personas muy especiales en San Atanasio. Además, deseo expresar la más profunda gratitud y aprecio a todos.
