Twenty Years is a Significant Period for A Lifetime...

“What is man that you should be mindful of him, or the son of man that you should care for him?” (PS 8:5)

Last week, you’ve read some information about the 20th Anniversary of my Priestly Ordination from the Valley Catholic in 1999. It said that “Some of the reasons Father Phan chose priesthood include: ‘To respond to Christ’s call for me.’ ‘To devote my whole life doing what I love to do—caring for God’s people.’ ‘To thank the American people for their generosity in receiving my family and relatives as well as other Vietnamese into this country.’” Well, after twenty years, my reasons are still the same. Yet, I have grown stronger in faith in God’s providence for me and the people of God; “the more we believe, the more we’ll receive.” There are some new gifts that I’ve acquired besides my gifts of drawing and designing: praying for rain, healing prayers, organizing groups, community building, empathetic listening and counseling, languages (although slowly but surely), cultural openness, etc....

To God, I give thanks each day. To the Bishops, pastors (including Fr. Oscar Tabujara) and my colleagues, I’m indebted to their generosity. I’m especially grateful for the love and guidance of my mother (Huong-Rose Nguyen), my late father (Ted Phan), my late sponsors/Irish parents (Millie and Bernie Murphy), my late auntie (Tuyet Nguyen), my late spiritual directors (Bob Giguere, Frank Norris, Bob Gavin, Tom Shae, John Hanley, Bill Carroll) and my spiritual directors through various periods of my life (Michael Murphy, Al Larkin, and Joe Fice). I’m totally ecstatic for the time spent as chaplain for the Boy Scouts of America in Santa Clara and National summer camps (1991 and 1997, respectively), Vietnamese Cursillo Spiritual Director for 8 years, president for the Vietnamese clergy and religious-Western Region for 5 years, national chaplain for Vietnamese Sacred Heart movement from 2014 to present. After all, it’s not how many things could one do in a lifetime; it’s how we grow more mature in discipleship to Christ during the process. I have become a more patient and compassionate person out of all these experiences. Gratefulness is the name of the game. It’s always been a privilege and honor to serve the Lord through the Church. Most of all, I’m grateful to the people of God for your care, love and forgiveness for me. At St. Athanasius, you’ve welcomed me twice and allowed me to exercise my ministries the best I can. May the Lord bless you and your families abundantly, and may the Blessed Mother, who identified with different cultures, care for you with the love beyond telling. Until we meet again, may the Holy Spirit always guide your way.

Estoy especialmente agradecido con mi Madre (Huong-Rose Nguyen) por su amor y guía, a mi difunto Padre (Ted Phan), a mis difuntos padrinos/ mis padres Irlandeses (Millie y Bernie Murphy), a mi difunta tia (Tuyet Nguyen), mis difuntos directores espirituales (Bob Giguere, Frank Norris, Bob Gavin, Tom Shae, John Hanley, Bill Carroll) y a mis directores espirituales en diferentes etapas de mi vida (Michael Murphy, Al Larkin, y Joe Fice). Estoy totalmente extasiado por el tiempo que pasé como capellán de Boy Scouts de América en Santa Clara y en los campamentos nacionales de verano (en 1991 y 1997, respectivamente), por ser el Director Espiritual Vietnamita de Cur-sillo por 8 años, el presidente de los sacerdotes y religiosas Vietnamitas el la Región Occidente por 5 años, el capellán Nacional del movimiento Vietnamita del Sagrado Corazón desde el 2014 hasta hoy en día. The Most Holy Trinity

The word “trinity” occurs nowhere in scripture, but the doctrine of the Trinity is basic to everything Christians believe. How did the church come to believe that the one God exists as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit? This complicated story is an example of the church being taught by the “Spirit of truth.”

In today’s first reading we hear that Wisdom is God’s “craftsman,” helping execute God’s plan for creation. The text is not about a helper god; it is an imaginative portrayal of Wisdom being both “of God” and external to God. We could say that Wisdom is God’s self-gift poured into creation, a sign that God loves creation, delights in it, and (in Genesis chapter 1) pronounces it “good.”

This is the most colorful Biblical portrayal of something “of God” that is given to creation, but there are others. In Isaiah 55:10–11, God’s Word (like the rain and snow) is sent down from heaven to do God’s will on earth, not returning until it is accomplished. God’s Word, like Wisdom, is also linked to creation, since in Genesis chapter 1, God creates by speaking, repeating “Let there be . . .” until the work is done.

THE MYSTERY OF FAITH

John’s Gospel begins, “In the beginning was the Word . . . and the Word was God”; John later adds “the Word became flesh” (John 1:14). This is more than poetic imagery. Here John makes a very bold claim. The prophets *proclaimed* God’s word, but Jesus *is* God’s Word—coming from God to us who are not God.

It took more than two hundred years before a universal Council declared that Jesus was “. . . true God from true God, begotten not made, consubstantial with the Father . . .” Slowly, the church was working toward a doctrine of the Trinity. The doctrine doesn’t explain the Trinity, but it does express the incomprehensible mystery of the God whose love overflows into the glories of creation, the messiness of our human condition, and the Spirit of truth that still guides the Church today.

La Santísima Trinidad

La palabra “trinidad” no está en las Escrituras, pero la doctrina de la Trinidad es básica para cada creencia cristiana. ¿Cómo la Iglesia llegó a creer que el único Dios existe como Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo? Esta historia compleja es un ejemplo de cómo la Iglesia es enseñada por el “Espíritu de la verdad”.

En la primera lectura de hoy, escuchamos que la Sabiduría es la “artesana”, ayudando a realizar el plan de Dios para la creación. El texto no es acerca de una buena ayudante, es un retrato imaginativo de

la Sabiduría siendo tanto “de Dios” y externa de Dios. Podríamos decir que la Sabiduría es el don propio de Dios derramado en la creación, un signo que Dios ama a la creación, se place en ella, y (en el capítulo 1 del libro del Génesis) la proclama “buena”.

Este es el retrato más colorido de algo “de Dios” que se da a la creación, pero hay otros. En Isaías 55, 10-11, la Palabra de Dios (como la lluvia y la nieve) baja del cielo para hacer la voluntad de Dios en la tierra, y no regresa hasta que la cumple. La Palabra de Dios, como la Sabiduría, también está vinculada con la creación, ya que, en el capítulo 1 del libro del Génesis, Dios crea al hablar, repitiendo “Hagamos. . .” hasta que la obra se realiza.

EL MISTERIO DE LA FE

El Evangelio de Juan empieza: “En el principio era la Palabra . . . y la Palabra era Dios”; más adelante Juan añade “la palabra se hizo carne” (Juan 1, 14). Esto es más que una imagen poética. Aquí Juan hace una afirmación muy audaz. El profeta proclama la palabra de Dios, pero Jesús es la Palabra de Dios, viniendo de Dios a nosotros que no somos Dios.

Requirió más de doscientos años antes de que un Concilio universal declarara que Jesús era “. . . Dios verdadero de Dios verdadero, engendrado, no creado, de la misma naturaleza del Padre . . .” Poco a poco la Iglesia fue elaborando una doctrina de la Trinidad. La doctrina no explica la Trinidad, pero expresa el misterio incomprendible de Dios cuyo amor desborda en la gloria de la creación, el desorden de la condición humana, y el Espíritu de la verdad que todavía hoy guía a la Iglesia.
