# SAINT ATHANASIUS

Dear parishioners of Saint Athanasius,

I want to thank you for the warm welcome you have given me since my first day at St. Athanasius. During the celebration of the Eucharist every weekend, and during my different visits to the different parish groups, I have experienced a genuinely sincere welcome from all of you. I want to also express my gratitude to my family, for the gift of life and faith, to my parents; Ernesto and Viviana, and to my sister Vero, although they are not physically present here today, they are always with me through their prayers and love. I want to thank Bishop Oscar Cantu for entrusting me with this great responsibility of guiding this beautiful community.

As you may already know, I was born in northern Argentina in a small town named Cafayate (somewhat like Napa Valley), after I had finished High School, I entered the seminary, which was located many miles away from my hometown in the center of the country, in Mendoza. During my time in the seminary, I learned not only philosophy and theology, but I had the opportunity to go on missions. At the end of every year, we went on missions in Argentina and in many countries of South America where I learned different realities and needs of the local people.

After my ordination, I was sent to Brooklyn, New York, in 1997 to learn English before I was to begin my permanent assignment. It was a beautiful pastoral experience, however, I did not get to learn the language, since I practiced my Spanish more due to the great need in the Hispanic community. At the end of that year jointly with two other priests, we embarked on a mission in northern Papua New Guinea where we stayed until the end of 1999. I have shared with some of you some of the stories of the extraordinary experiences I had in this mission on this island full of beauty and challenges. We will have plenty of time and many more opportunities in the future to share more about the beginnings of this mission and my first years of priesthood.

After the Papua New Guinea mission, I took a few months off to rest, and I had the opportunity to travel to Holy Land for the jubilee year in 2000. It was a great experience to be able to spend time with other missionaries in our Lord's land culminating with a Mass in the Mount of the Beatitudes concelebrating with Pope John Paul II.

In May of 2000, my new pastoral assignment was in the Diocese of San Jose, in the Saint Leo the Great parish. I was blessed to work as parochial vicar in different churches in the Diocese including the St Joseph Cathedral of San Jose until I was named Pastor of the Sacred Heart Church in 2008. I learned so much at Sacred Heart, where I spent half of my combined years of priesthood. I have many delightful memories of that community and the neighborhood that became my home and my family. Many anecdotes and stories of the challenges and accomplishments of such a vibrant community helped me grow as a priest and in my spiritual life. A special thank you to the staff and the community at Sacred Heart Church for all the support during my time with them.

In 2017 I took some enrichment workshops in Rome and had the great blessing of concelebrating with Pope Francis at the canonization Mass of the Child Martyrs of Tlaxcala, Mexico.

As I begin my responsibilities at Saint Athanasius, I would like to thank you again for welcoming me and I entrust myself to your prayers so that the Lord can make me a pastor according to His heart and give me wisdom and fortitude to guide His flock.

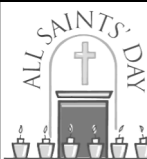

## BOLETIN HISPANO

Estimados Feligreses de San Atanasio,  
Quiero agradecerles inmensamente la calurosa bienvenida que nos han dado desde el primer día aquí en la parroquia. Tanto en las celebraciones de la Eucaristía, de cada fin de semana, como en la visita de los distintos grupos he podido experimentar esa sincera bienvenida. Un agradecimiento también a mi familia por el don de la vida y de la fe. A mis papás Ernesto y Viviana, y mi hermana Vero que, aunque no pueden estar presentes este fin de semana me acompañan siempre con su oración y con su afecto. Un agradecimiento también al Sr. Obispo Oscar Cantú por su confianza en darme esta gran responsabilidad de pastorear esta hermosa comunidad.

Como algunos de ustedes ya saben yo nací en el norte de Argentina en un pequeño pueblo llamado Cafayate (es como un pequeño Napa Valley), después de que terminara mi preparatoria entré al seminario que está a muchas millas de mi lugar de origen, en el centro del país, en Mendoza. Durante el tiempo de seminario tuve la oportunidad no solo de aprender filosofía y teología, sino también de misionar. Al fin de cada año pudimos salir a la misión tanto en Argentina como en varios países de Sudamérica y conocer las distintas realidades y necesidades de la gente.

Después de mi ordenación sacerdotal fui enviado en 1997 a Brooklyn en New York para aprender inglés antes de ir a mi destino definitivo. Fue una hermosa experiencia pastoral, pero en cuanto al aprendizaje de la lengua, practiqué más mi español que lo que pude aprender inglés por la gran necesidad de la comunidad hispana. Al final de ese año junto a otros dos sacerdotes comenzamos la misión en el norte de Papua Nueva Guinea allí estuvimos hasta el final de 1999. Les he platicado algunas historias de esa extraordinaria experiencia de la misión en esa isla llena de belleza y de desafíos. Tendremos más tiempo y oportunidades de compartir acerca de esos comienzos de la misión y de mis primeros años de sacerdocio.

Tuve unos meses de descanso en los que tuve la oportunidad de viajar a Tierra Santa por el año del Jubileo del año 2000. Fue una gran experiencia compartir ese tiempo tan especial con otros misioneros en la tierra del Señor y culminar con una misa en la montaña de las bienaventuranzas concelebrando con el Papa Juan Pablo II.

En mayo del 2000 mi nuevo destino fue la Diócesis de San José y mi primera tarea pastoral fue la parroquia de St. Leo the Great. Tuve la gran bendición de ejercer el ministerio como vicario parroquial en varias iglesias incluyendo la St. Joseph Cathedral hasta ser nombrado párroco de la iglesia del Sagrado Corazón en San José en el 2008. Allí aprendí mucho y ejercí la mitad de los años de mi ministerio. Muchos hermosos recuerdos de la comunidad y del barrio que se transformó en mi casa y mi familia. Hay muchas bonitas historias y anécdotas de los logros y los desafíos de una comunidad vibrante que me ayudo a crecer en mi sacerdocio y en mi vida espiritual. Un gran agradecimiento al staff y a la comunidad del Sagrado Corazón por todos esos años. En el año 2017 visitando Roma para unos talleres de actualización tuve la gran bendición de concelebrar con el Papa Francisco en la Misa de canonización de los primeros niños mártires mexicanos.

Al comenzar mis responsabilidades en la comunidad de San Atanasio les agradezco nuevamente su bienvenida y me encomiendo a sus oraciones para que el Señor nos haga pastores según su corazón y nos de sabiduría y fortaleza para guiar a su rebaño.
