Dear Parishioners,

Pope Francis said “Faith is an encounter with Jesus, and we must do what Jesus does, encounter others.” Every day we encounter others in our Parish and Diocese. People are brought together from all walks of life through a variety of ministries and services to do God’s work of justice, mercy, outreach and formation. **Encountering Christ, Faith in Action**, the Annual Diocesan Appeal for the Diocese of San Jose, provides the financial support of these ministries and services for all Catholics in our community.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for having given generously of your prayer, time, talent and treasure to continue God’s work here at Saint Athanasius. Your generosity toward the 2020 Annual Diocesan Appeal will provide essential support to Saint Athanasius and the other parishes of our local Church for programs like Catechesis and Faith Formation, Liturgical Minister Formation, Youth and Young Adult Ministry, Life, Justice & Peace, Family Life Ministries, Ministries for Cultural Diversity and Tuition Assistance for our Catholic Elementary Schools.

The ADA also supports the formation and ongoing education of our future priests and deacons, the Institute for Leadership in Ministry for our parish leaders and the professional development of our current priests.

Here at Saint Athanasius we benefit tremendously from your support of the ADA. Our **diocesan goal for this year is \$ 72,282** and, as we have done in previous years, we will add our **parish goal of \$60,000** making our over-all **2020 ADA goal to \$ 132,282**. All monies that are collected over our parish goal will be rebated directly back to our parish to use for our own ministries and other parish needs. In 2019 our parish received a rebate of \$79,496.47 that was used for *the tenting and fumigation (for termites) of our 2 portable classroom buildings and repairing/resealing/re-stripping of church parking lot*. In looking toward 2020, our Parish Council has committed to use our 2020 ADA rebate for *improving the Sanctuary of the church, and painting and refurbishment of our parish hall and kitchen*. Even if you have not pledged in the past, please prayerfully consider supporting this mission.

I am confident that this year’s ADA will be another success and a testimony of your commitment not only for Saint Athanasius, but for the Church’s important work in the Santa Clara Valley. With your continued support and commitment, we will truly **Encounter Christ** in our parish and our greater Catholic community.


