The 2020 theme for the Annual Diocesan Appeal is, *‘Encountering Christ – Faith in Action.’* One of the constant themes of Pope Francis in his preaching and exhortations is our call to become ‘missionary disciples.’ That term has two distinct, but complementary, elements to it: *following* Christ as his disciples and being *sent to witness* to God’s love, truth, and beauty. So, too, does our 2020 theme bear these two important elements: encountering Christ and putting faith into action.

We might ask, how should we do this? The traditional triad helps us in accomplishing these goals of encountering Christ and putting our faith into action: Know Him, Love Him, Serve Him. Through the assistance of the ADA, the diocese helps us to ‘Know Christ, Love Him, and Serve Him’ through the Office of Catechesis and Faith Formation; the Office of Family Life & Spirituality; the Office for Youth and Young Adults; the Institute for Leadership in Ministry; the Office of Liturgy, Prayer, and Sacraments; the Office of Vocations; and the Office of Life, Justice, and Peace, among others. Thus, in the 2020 ADA theme we have an entire working plan for encountering Christ and putting our faith into action!

I invite you to be a part of helping others in the Diocese of San Jose to encounter Christ and to place their faith in action by participating in the ADA 2020. Be assured of my daily prayers for you. May we all build each other up in prayer and good works!

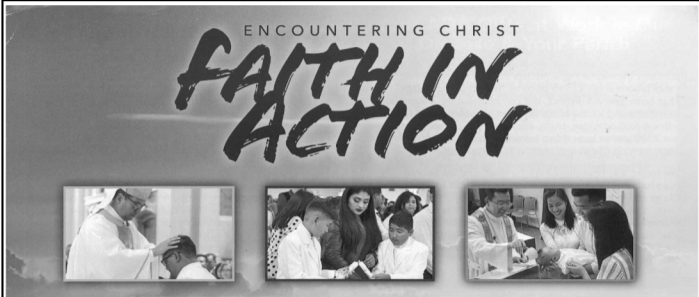
