After consulting with the parishioners, our staff and many of the parish committees; such as the liturgy committee and the Pastoral Council, we have seen the need to make some modifications in the daily Masses and also on the Saturday Masses.

Most of the parishioners who attend these Masses have given their support to this proposal. Also in the daily Mass at 9:00 am we will introduce some prayers in Spanish to give a better welcome to our brothers of the Hispanic community who participate in the daily Mass. Changes are always difficult at the beginning, but many times they are very much necessary.

### The New Mass Schedule reflecting the changes will be effective Monday, March 2nd:

The 6:45 AM daily Mass will be moved to **7:00 AM**

The 9 AM daily Mass will have some prayers in Spanish

The 5:30 PM English Mass on Saturday will be moved to **5:00 PM**

The 7:30 PM Spanish Mass on Saturday will be moved to **7:00 PM**

**Confessions will be Bilingual at 4 pm and 6 PM every Saturday**

**There will be no change on Sunday Masses.**

**Service of Liturgy of the Word (only) with Distribution of Ashes at Noon (English) and 1:00pm (Spanish)**

Please remember, Ash Wednesday is a day of **FASTING** and **ABSTINENCE**.

**Lenten Fasting Requirements**

**Minimum Fasting Requirements:** Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 are obliged to fast on **Ash Wednesday and Good Friday**. In addition, all Catholics 14 years old and older must abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Fridays of Lent.

**Fasting** means partaking of only one full meal. Some food (not equaling another full meal) is permitted at breakfast and around midday or in the evening—depending on when a person chooses to eat the main or full meal.

**Abstinence** forbids the use of meat, but not of eggs, milk products or condiments made of animal fat, such as margarine or lard.

**AYUNAR** como esta descrito por los obispos de Los Estados Unidos, es el hecho de comer solamente una comida entera durante el día en porciones durante el desayuno, al mediodía y por la noche. Todas las porciones deben equivaler solamente a una comida completa.

**ABSTINENCIA** prohíbe el consumo de carnes, pero no el de huevos, leche o condimentos hechos de grasa animal tal como la manteca o la margarina.
